





Ezekiel 33:7–11

⁷"So you, son of man, I have made a watchman for the house of Israel. spiritual Rock that followed them, and the Rock was Christ. ⁵Nevertheless, with most of them God was not pleased, for they were overthrown in the wilderness.








*Nicene Creed
