"Pentecost, God Sends the Holy Spirit"

Bible verse: "And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh" Joel 2:28

The historical and Biblical origins of Pentecost can be found in Exodus 23:14-19, Leviticus 23:15-16 and Deuteronomy 16:10. One of 3 significant Jewish festivals, Pentecost is the Greek name for the Festival of Weeks, a prominent feast in the Jewish calendar that celebrated God giving them the 10 Commandments 50 days after the Exodus from Egypt. God instructed his people to celebrate the Festival of Weeks, which was to be held 7 full weeks (49 days) plus one day after Passover, equaling 50 days. Also called the Feast of Harvest, this was when the Jews would present offerings of the first fruits of their spring crops. Jewish law required all adult Jewish men to come to Jerusalem from wherever they were living to personally be in attendance for the celebration.

Pentecost, which means "fiftieth," occurred fifty days after Jesus' glorious resurrection on Easter. Forty days after He rose again, Jesus ascended to God's right hand, and now, ten days later, He fulfills His promise to send the Holy Spirit, who will "bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you" (John 14:26).

Key Point of the Lesson

At Pentecost, God sent the Holy Spirit to His Church. Through Word and Sacrament. God gives us His Holy Spirit to create and sustain saving faith in Jesus.

Law / Gospel

We see God's love in the Old Testament book of Joel: God warns guilty sinners of the judgement to come. He pleads with them to repent and promises to forgive all their sins. We sin when we believe that we can understand and trust in God on our own. We need the power and work of the Holy Spirit through His Word, the Spirit grants me faith in Jesus and empowers me to do that which is good and God pleasing.

Devotional Talk: An adult or older child can read this to the family.

Tell the Good News ~ Acts 2:1-41 (from "Family Time Bible Stories and Devotions", CPH publishing)

Imagine this: You're going to appear on television! A talent agent saw you walking out of school and decided that you had excellent feet. So she asked you to make a shoe commercial to be seen on national television. This was such good news that you had to tell everyone. You called all your friends and relatives to tell them the good news.

Good news must be told. That's how it was on Pentecost, almost two thousand years ago. Only a small number of people knew what Jesus had done for them. Most of them spoke the same language, so people in other lands had little chance of hearing the Good News.

God took care of that problem. He sent the Holy Spirit to His followers and enabled them to speak in languages they hadn't known before. Those who received this power proclaimed news of the Savior to everyone who would listen.

Wouldn't it be awesome if you had that power? You can't expect another Pentecost, so if you want to tell others about Jesus in their own language, you'll have to learn it the normal way. You can tell others about Jesus right now, though-speaking the language God gives you.

And the Holy Spirit will help you. He will give you the words to use to tell others that God loves them and that Jesus died to take away their sins. You can pray that missionaries will continue to work with people who don't know Jesus. You also can ask the Holy Spirit to soften the heart of those who oppose God and open the hearts of those who hear God's Word.

Prayer: Thank you God for sending Your Holy Spirit, so I can help others know about their Savior, Jesus Christ. I pray this in Your holy name. Amen

Pentecost

MATH


Show things with three parts: sides of a triangle, leaves on a clover, petals on a trillium, parts of an apple (seeds, flesh, skin).




